Clear voice that is heard easily			
Loud whistle that can be heard by all players

Game Management			
Confident in making decisions at this level			
Signals goals scored			
Indicates centre passes			
Indicates and controls throw ins			
Most times indicates clearly to correctly set a penalty

Shows a developing understanding of positioning and repositioning to clearly see play			
Recognises most instances of footwork			
Displays a knowledge of minor infringements (ie. playing the ball, over a third, held ball, offside, breaking, short pass)
